

# Iglesia Evangélica Presbyteriana Getsemani

In 2003, First Presbyterian Church of West Chester began a formal covenant relationship with the Iglesia Evangélica Presbyteriana Getsemani in Villa Nueva, Guatemala, As the signed covenant document describes. "We are joined in mutual respect and willingness to learn from one another, support each other, and grow together as disciples of our Savior and Lord."





One very important part of this ministry is our annual visits with each other: they travel here one year; we travel there the opposite year. These opportunities to visit in person have been very important to build this ministry as we worship together, learn together and share with each other about how Christ is working in our lives.

On our trips to visit Getsemani we experience a wide variety of activities. We've been able to participate in their church's Vacation Bible School. We worship in

their Sunday service and with their Women's Fellowship and their Friday night Men's Fellowship. We attend presentations to understand the Guatemalan culture, visit historical sites to learn about their history and see nonprofits addressing challenging social issues. We have opportunities to share meals and conversation with the people of Getsemani church to talk about our churches and our faith.
